

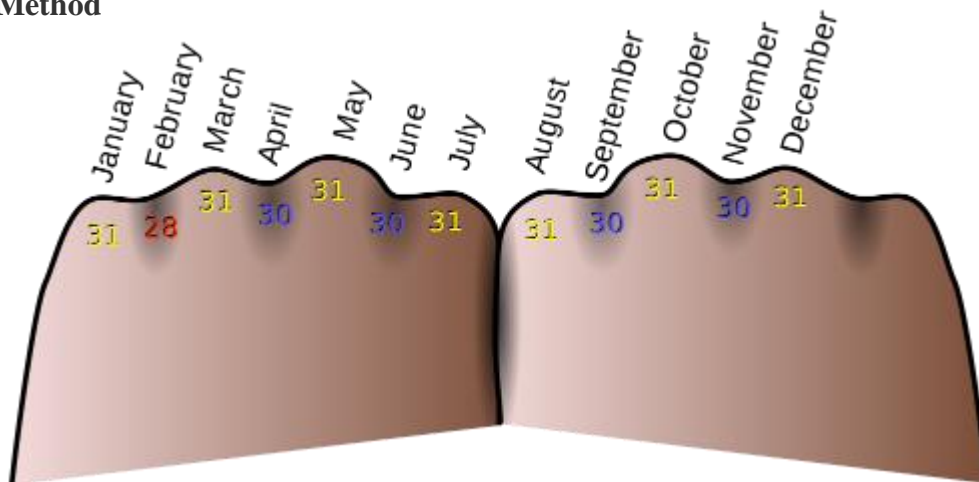
How Many Days Are in Each Month?

2 Ways to Remember

1. "Thirty Days Hath September" Poem/Nursery Rhyme:

*Thirty days hath September,
April, June, and November;
All the rest have Thirty-one,
Except February, which is twenty-eight;
But in leap year we assign
February with twenty-nine.*

2. Knuckle Method



A knuckle is "31 days" and in between each knuckle is "30 days" - except for February, which will be "28" (or "29 days" during a leap year).

Example: October is **on** a knuckle, so it has "31 days"; whereas, November is **not** a knuckle so it has "30 days".

Note: Where your thumbs meet, the two knuckles are "July, August", which both have 31 days.
(Note: the last knuckle isn't used)
